



# Hiking Kit Checklist

Listed below are the minimum items that should be in your hiking emergency first aid kit. When you and your pup are out on the trail and you realize a dog is in need of medical attention, you don't have time to go find these items. **Every second counts!** Please keep a first aid kit ready and handy! *Be sure to check dates and replace, even if unopened, when you replace your smoke detector batteries.*

- \_\_\_\_\_ Benadryl tablets
- \_\_\_\_\_ Bottled water
- \_\_\_\_\_ Flashlight with good batteries (*test often*)
- \_\_\_\_\_ Gauze pads and gauze rolls (*several*)
- \_\_\_\_\_ Muzzle
- \_\_\_\_\_ Water bowl (*collapsible, light and compact*)
